General Tracking and Cautionary Disclaimers are as follows:

No dogs are allowed to be "off lead" due to the changing nature of the fields used by clubs for tracking tests and the increased population at these sites by the general public. Dogs shall be "on lead" at all times on any area of the tracking site. Cancellation of Event may occur due to extreme hazardous weather conditions as determined by the Tracking Committee and Judges.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The drawing will be random and will determine which entries will participate. Preference will be given, however, to dogs who have not previously earned a TD or TDU. A worker draw will be used for this test in accordance with the parameters set forth in Ch. 1, Sec 17d of the Tracking Regulations and as determined by the Board of Directors. For each the TD and TDU, 1 track will be set aside for a worker. Tracks may be exchanged between the two tests.

WHEN THE ADVERTISED LIMIT OF ENTRIES has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preference set forth above, shall be drawn for a position on the Alternate List, corresponding to the order in which they were drawn. The test secretary will notify all entries of the results of the drawing by email if a valid email address has been provided. Entrants may call the test secretary (207) 522-9570 until 8:00 PM concerning the results of the drawing.

ENTRY FEE: TD / TDU \$75

(Includes AKC \$3.50 recording & event fees)

A written AKC Certification must accompany the Entry for any dog that has not previously passed an AKC tracking test.

ALL ENTRY FEES PAYABLE IN U.S. FUNDS ONLY. Checks or money orders payable to Dog Tracking Club of Maine.

WITHDRAWALS: In the event an accepted entry withdraws after the Closing Date to allow an alternate to replace said entry, the entry fee will be refunded. In the event an accepted entry withdraws after the closing date and there is no alternate to replace said entry, the entry fee will not be refunded. Refunds will be mailed after the test.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be allowed to participate in the test only after all other dogs and bitches not in season have been tested.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
